Potters have been a mainstay in the area for centuries. During this interactive workshop, local potters demonstrate how design and production methods have evolved, while participants produce and take home a piece of pottery.

Take a ceramics class at Mariela's house in Huayoccari, a serene village where ancient traditions whisper through time. Immerse yourself in a creative journey, exploring unique styles, experimenting with textures, colours and forms to convey your personal narratives and cultural themes in your ceramics. Enjoy feeling the cool, malleable clay in your hands as you employ methods dating back to the Incas—secrets of form and function that have stood the test of time.

From hand-building to wheel-throwing, each method reveals a different facet of ceramics. You will be guided by instructors who are as passionate about teaching as they are about their heritage. Whether you're a novice exploring ceramics for the first time, or an experienced artist seeking to refine your craft, this ceramics workshop is a sanctuary where art and tradition converge, and where clay becomes a canvas for imagination.
