
CULTURE BY VIENTO SUR



The Peruvian Paso Horse is a unique breed, famed for its four-beat, lateral gait, elegance and gentle temperament.

These horses hold deep historical and cultural significance in Peru and are a much loved and respected breed worldwide, combining the virtues of the Arabic, Berber and Andalusian breeds and descended from the original horses shipped over by the Spanish conquistadors. A show is held daily at Sol y Luna, during which the Peruvian Pasos demonstrate their exquisite movement to the rhythm of the Marinera, a Peruvian dance that encapsulates hispanic equestrian traditions.
