## Take a magnificent journey through the Sacred Valley, discovering hamlets and villages, gardens, fields, woodland and Incan ruins.

A three hour off-road ride along the valley floor, beginning in Lamay, village of the roasted guinea pig fame. The trail takes a bridge over the Urubamba River, before following the river itself through the rural valley. Two hours in and you reach the idyllic Inca village of Urquillos, where you visit the Plaza de Armas with stunning views over the ancient church. A further hour on the e-bike to reach the village of Huayllabamba, before the trip concludes at Yucay, where your transport back to the hotel awaits.

Glimpse a fascinating world where locals still engage in ancient farming practices. The end point, Yucay, is said to be one of the most beautiful towns in the Sacred Valley, and indeed the world, if local tourist guides are to be believed!
