An adrenaline-filled, downhill e-bike adventure from the Quechuan village of Misminay with spectacular views of the archaeological site of Moray, with its ancient Incan terraces.

This is an adrenaline-filled, downhill e-bike adventure, beginning 40 minutes from Sol y Luna at the enchanting Quechuan village of Misminay. Once bikes are unloaded, the journey begins, offering bikers spectacular views of the archaeological site of Moray as they descend. This famous site is believed to have been a laboratory and agricultural research center during the time of the Inca Empire; the well-preserved, concentric terraces are thought to have been used by the Incas to experiment with crops and environmental conditions. A car returns guests to Sol y Luna for a restorative lunch or aperitif, depending on timings.

Guests should prepare for an exhilarating, challenging two-wheeled descent.
