ADVENTURE BY VIENTO SUR



A 3 hour walk from the village of Yucay along footpaths through terraces, fields and orchards incorporating ancient cave paintings, Inca relics and captivating views.

A three hour walk, suitable for all abilities, beginning close to the hotel by the ancient church in the rural village of Yucay. The trail follows well-marked footpaths and covers terraces, fields and orchards before reaching a viewpoint adorned with cave paintings. It's a straightforward route back to the village through pasture and orchards with appealing views for the duration.

This is a captivating trip with excellent views, encompassing ancient Inca infrastructure including terraces, irrigation canals and old haciendas and the cave paintings of Ayawayq'o and T'oqoq'oqoyoq.
